How to Apply to Save Money on Internet Access

- To see if you are eligible for a \$30/month discount (or \$75/month for households on tribal lands) via the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), go to <http://getinternet.gov>.
- Click the + sign beside "Find Out If You Qualify" to see if you meet any of the three qualifications.
- If you meet any of the three qualifications, scroll down to Step 1 of the How to Sign Up for the Affordable Connectivity Program section.
- Click the drop down arrow to select how you would like to qualify. Answer any additional questions and click "Apply Now."
- You can also download a paper application to mail in if you prefer.

New: \$30 High-Speed Internet Plans

- The federal government has secured 20 leading internet providers to offer ACP-eligible households a high-speed internet plan for no more than \$30 per month.
- Eligible families who pair their ACP benefit with one of these plans can receive high-speed internet at no cost.
